



Travel Medicine Information Sheet

Jupiter Medical Center Urgent Care's Travel Medicine Program provides destination-specific travel health recommendations and requirements as well as travel safety tips. To participate in the Travel Medicine Program, you must be 18 years or older.

Please follow the checklist below to partake in Jupiter Medical Center's Travel Medicine process:

- Fill out a Travel Vaccine Questionnaire that is easily obtained by downloading it from <https://www.jupitermedurgentcare.com/> or stopping by any of the 5 Jupiter Medical Center Urgent Care locations.
- Return completed Travel Vaccine Questionnaire to Jupiter Medical Center Urgent Care via one of the following methods:
 - Drop it off at any of the 5 Jupiter Medical Center Urgent Care locations.
 - Fax it to (561) 776-3998.
 - Email it to sofia.kohn@jupitermed.com.
 - Mail it to 5430 Military Trail Suite 64 Jupiter, FL 33458.
- A Jupiter Medical Center employee will call to collect the nonrefundable \$50 Travel Processing Fee, if the fee was not collected in person. This fee is due prior to the processing of your travel report and is separate from any vaccine and/or prescription charges. The processing fee is to allow the Travel Medicine Liaison to run your itinerary through the Travax Travelers Report system and to ensure proper requirements and recommendations are being made.
- The Travel Medicine Liaison will email you your destination-specific Travax Travelers Report indicating all required and recommended vaccinations and safety tips within 3-5 business days of receiving the completed Travel Vaccine Questionnaire.
- Review your Travax Travelers Report in its entirety and email the Travel Medicine Liaison regarding the vaccines and/or prescriptions you would like to receive. Appointments are required for this specific service.
- The Travel Medicine Liaison will work with you to book an appointment at Jupiter Medical Center's Donald Ross location (5430 Military Trail Suite 64 Jupiter, FL 33458). If for any reason you require your Travel Medicine appointment to be at another Jupiter Medical Center Urgent Care location, this can be accommodated if it is discussed in advance.
- During your appointment, you will receive the agreed upon vaccines and prescriptions along with a Yellow Card as proof of vaccination. You may make any follow up appointments necessary to complete a vaccine series at this time as well.
